PROGRAMS OFFERED

LL.B. – 3 Year Course B.A. LL.B. – 5 Year Integrated Course

B.A. LL.B.

Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Laws (B.A.LL.B.) (5 Year Integrated Course)

B.A.LL.B. is a professional course which is an integrated programme, for the students, who have passed intermediate form any recognized board, are eligible to take admission in this course. The durations of this course are five academic years, each year is divided into two semesters. Examination is conducted by Ch. Charan Singh University, first semester in December - January and second semester in May-June. No age limit is for the course and college has 120 seats in this course and follows all the rules formed by the University and Bar Council of India.

Intake: 120 seats

Duration: 5 Year (Ten Semesters)

Eligibility Criteria:

Candidate have passed the Higher Secondary School Examination (10+2) system or an equivalent examination thereto securing in the aggregate not less than 45% of the total marks (40% in case of SC/ST/Persons, with Disability) or as per guidelines of Bar Council of India/ Chaudhary Charan Singh University Meerut.

The prescribed application form should be accompanied by the following documents : –

LL.B.

Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) / (3 Year Course)

LL.B Course is the professional 3 year course which encompasses the foundations of legal knowledge. These are the essential components that satisfy the Bar Council and Law Society professional requirements. In the first year you will take all core modules, whilst the second and third years offer a broad range of optional modules to allow you to widen your interests. We engage visiting lecturers who are at the forefront of legal practice in the City, as well as our own academics who are leading researchers in the legal sphere. There is no age limit for this course, college has 120 seats in this course and follows all the rules formed by the University and Bar Council of India.

Intake: 120 seats

Duration: 3 Year (Six Semesters)

Eligibility Criteria:

An applicant who has graduated in any discipline of knowledge from a university established by an Act of Parliament or by a State Legislature or an equivalent National Institution recognized as a deemed University or Foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for 3 year degree in Law, For admission to the 3 Year LL.B. Course, a person shall possess a U.G./P.G. Degree from any recognised university with a minimum of 45% marks, OBC 42% and 40% in case of SC and ST applicants as per Bar Council of India (BCI) The student should have undertaken 10+2+3 pattern of studies.

Student's admission to the course is purely provisional and the same will be confirmed only after admission is approved by Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut. In case of non approval fees paid by the student will not be refunded.
